Topic: President Trump and presidential power

Main lesson focus (underline one): Listening

Learner outcome(s): The students will be able to answer listening comprehension questions based on a news story recording and then discuss presidential power.

Grammar:

Vocabulary: to reshape, to vow, fossil fuels, to drill

Assumptions: For this lesson I assume the Ss already know something about Donald Trump.

An anticipated problem: The listening may be challenging for them, even though the recording is Level 1 on Breaking News English.

My proposed solution: They will listen once for gist, a second time for detail, and a third time with the transcript.

What I intend to work on based on previous feedback: Don't tell the students what speed the recording is at! Make sure that students understand instructions.

While Listening	Set up Listen 1. Provide students with the title of the news story and also with the focus question:	Introduce students to the news story and task.	L
20 minutes	Does President Trump suggest that he believes in God?	Encourage students to first focus on gist.	
	Set up Listen 2. Ask students to read the 6 true and false sentences, then during listen 2., decide which are true and false.	Encourage students to now focus on detail.	
	I will pause the recording sentence by sentence for Listen 2.		
	For Listen 3., give the students the transcript so that they can read along. Consider speeding up the delivery speed depending on how it is going.	Provide the students an opportunity to see the full text and to further their understanding of the news story vocabulary and content.	

Production 15 mins	In twos, one partner draws a card, reads it out, and answers. Take turns drawing cards. Each person should talk for two mintues. Model this.	Place the news story in a larger context about political leadership and power. Provide an opportunity for the students to discuss the topic freely, listening to each other and each other's ideas.	S
Recap and Error Correction 5 mins	Fold any error correction from the production exercise into the recap at the end; focus on vocabulary.

"The Golden Age of America"

President Donald Trump has promised a "golden age" for America. He was sworn in as the USA's 47th President on the 20th of January. He was also the 45th when he served in that role from 2017 to 2021. He made his acceptance speech in Washington, D.C. He promised to reshape America, stating: "The golden age of America begins right now. From this day forward, our country will [grow] and be respected again all over the world. We will be the envy of every nation." He added that: "During every single day of the Trump administration, I will very simply put America first." President Trump said he had a God-given mission.

He spoke about the assassination attempt in July. He said: "My life was saved...by God to make America great again." One of Trump's biggest promises was for American astronauts to plant the Stars and Stripes flag on Mars. He vowed to strengthen the US economy. He also said he would use America's fossil fuels. He said: "We will drill, baby, drill." He added: "We have something that no other manufacturing nation will ever have – the largest amount of oil and gas of any country on Earth. And we are going to use it."
